Carry out the standard in port daily routine as prescribed in COMMANDING OFFICER'S INSTRUCTION 5203.2 Change 2, except as modified below:

UNIFORM OF THE DAY (before 0800)

Officers and CPO's - Service Dress Blue BRAVO

Enlisted - Dress Blue BRAVO

UNIFORM OF THE DAY (after 0800)

Officers and CPO's - Full Dress Blue BRAVO (overcoats may be prescribed)

Enlisted - Full Dress Blue BRAVO (peacoats may be prescribed)

- 0530 - Reveille. Liberty expires.
0600 - 0645 - Breakfast for crew and officers on Mission Bay.
0615 - Division Officers obtain service, dental, health, and pay records and orders for men of their divisions from Personnel Office, and travel/advance pay checks from Supply Office.
0645 - Quarters for muster. Officers call.
- Division Officers have men sign original orders and one copy - send signed copy to Personnel Office along with muster reports, liberty cards, and mess passes immediately after quarters. Deliver records, orders, and checks to men concerned, insuring that men understand where and when they are to report.
0700 - 0900 - All hands turn in blankets which are the property of the Government to representative of First Lieutenant on the dock. Finish clearing and cleaning APL.
0845 - On deck Sideboys (8).
0930 - Muster crew aft for decommissioning ceremony.
1000 - Commence decommissioning ceremony.
- After decommissioning, the Commanding Officer wishes all hands a good cruise.

NOTES

- ATTENTION ALL HANDS: Transportation will be available after the decommissioning ceremony on the following basis:
 - There will be two Navy shuttle buses running from the ship to gate #32 commencing at 1030.
 - There will be one Navy bus leaving the ship for the Receiving Station at Brooklyn, N.Y., to transport those men who have been ordered there.
 - Commercial transportation is provided on a pay-as-you-go basis (40¢) stopping at the Port Authority Terminal on 42nd St, Penn Station, and Grand Central Station. One bus is available for this service.
- ATTENTION ALL HANDS: Outgoing mail will close out at 0600 today.
- ATTENTION ALL HANDS: Cameras may be brought on the base for taking pictures of the Decommissioning Ceremony only. Taking pictures other than of the Ceremony is strictly forbidden. Hosts are responsible for their guests.

ATTENTION ALL POST DECOMMISSIONING DETAIL: Weekend liberty will expire for all members of the post-decommissioning detail on Monday at 0810 on the Mission Bay. Quarters will be held on the Mission Bay at 0815.
