

May your memories of this day be longer than we left your hair, warmer than we left your pants and tenderer than we left your posterior.



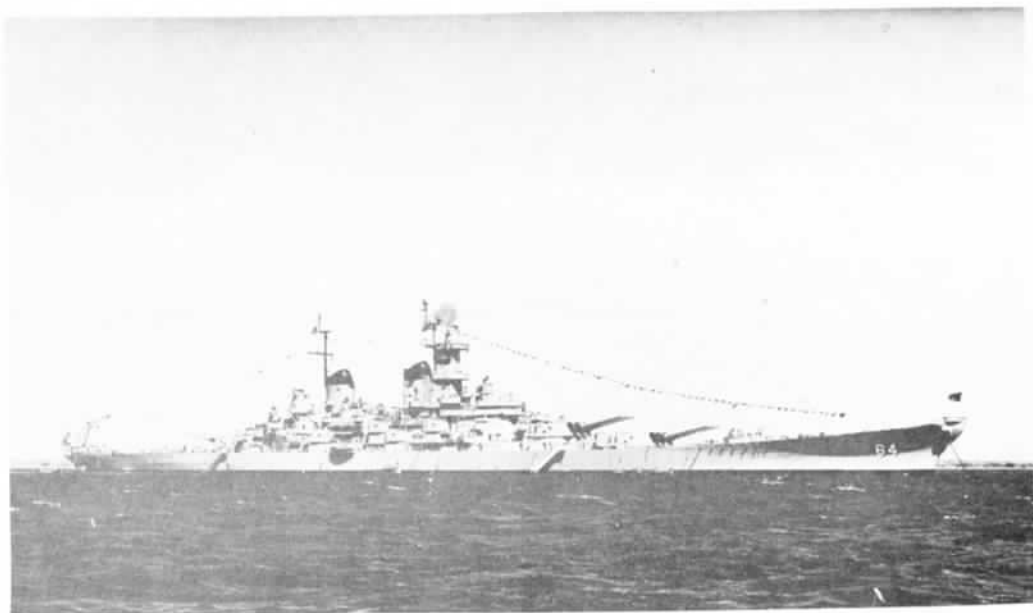

U.S.S. WISCONSIN

FIRST IN FIFTY YEARS....

* * * * *

For the first time in half a century the Midshipmen Summer Cruise headed for a port in South America south of the Equator.

True, in 1940, all plans had been completed for the Summer Practice Cruise to take such a trip but Italy attacked France in June 1940. The squadron was already in the vicinity of the Bahamas, heading south, when the news came over the air and plans to take them so far from home waters were promptly canceled.

Under more favorable auspices, the 1953 Midshipmen Practice Squadron sailed for South American shores on June 8. This squadron consisted of 28 warships with more than 1850 Naval Academy and 1300 Naval R.O.T.C. Midshipmen aboard.

Rear Admiral E. T. Wooldridge, USN, Cruise Commander in the USS MISSOURI, led the Practice Squadron to southern waters. A few miles off the Brazilian coast, the squadron separated. Under the command of Rear Admiral E. T. Wooldridge, the battleships WISCONSIN and MISSOURI, tankers AUCILLA and SABINE, submarine GRENADIER and ten destroyer types proceeded to Rio de Janeiro for an eight-day good-will visit arriving on the morning of June 27. The Santos element, under the command of Rear Admiral R.F. Stout, USN, in the heavy cruiser U.S.S. MACON, included the cruiser ALBANY, carrier SAIPAN, tanker CHIPOLA and ten destroyer-type vessels.

The 28 ships left the Brazilian ports on July 5 enroute for the Caribbean. The Wisconsin and six other warships visited Trinidad, British West Indies, their second port-of-call, from July 22 to 25 with Captain Robert J. Foley, USN, Commanding Officer of the U.S.S. WISCONSIN, as senior officer of the group. The remainder of the Practice Squadron, separated into smaller operating groups, visited Colon, Panama; Cartagena and Barranquilla, Colombia; Willemstad, Curacao; and Barbados, British West Indies, during the same period.

The entire Practice Squadron then proceeded to Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, for final gunnery exercises which concluded the 1953 Midshipmen Cruise on August 4, disembarking the midshipmen in Norfolk, Virginia.

THE ANCIENT TRADITION OF BECOMING A SHELLBACK

* * * *

The boisterous ceremonies of "crossing the line" are of such ancient vintage that their derivation is lost. It is well known that ceremonies took place long ago when the ship crossed the thirtieth parallel, and also when going through the Straits of Gibraltar. These early ceremonies were of the roughest sort and were, to a great extent, supposed to try the crew to determine whether or not the novices on their first cruise would endure the hardships of a life at sea. Then, as is the custom of the present time, it was primarily a crew's "party."

At an early date, ceremonies of propitiation were carried on. Neptune, the mythological god of the seas, was appeased by the seamen, and marks of respect were paid those of his underwater domain. It is plausible that a part of the ceremony grew out of tradition of other days, even though sailors had come to doubt the existence of Neptune. Nevertheless, Neptunus Rex is today the majesty who rules in the ceremonies.

Those who have crossed the line are called "shellbacks!" These Sons of Neptune compose the cast for the present-day ceremonies. It is a curious fact of human nature, but "pollywogs" will suffer a very severe initiation in order to become shellbacks.

Ceremonies of the modern Navy are picturesque. With the exception of the discomfort of a good wetting in the tank, the shillalah line and the shaving ceremony, the initiation cannot be called extremely rough.

The eldest and most dignified shellback of the crew is usually selected as Neptunus Rex; his first assistant is Davy Jones. Her Highness Amphitrite is usually a seaman who will appear well in the deshabelle of seaweed and rope yarns with his face made up with red lead, lamp black and wheat flour. The court in general consists of the Royal Scribe, the Royal Dentist, the Royal Doctor, the Royal Chaplain, and other names that suit the fancy of the party. The Bears have the difficult task of rounding up the uninitiated, and also standing "dousing" watches in the canvas water tank.

The night before the ship crosses the line, it is the custom that Davy Jones shall appear on board with a message to the Captain from His Majesty, Neptunus Rex, stating at what time he wants the ship hove to for the reception of the Royal Party, and with summons for the Pollywogs to appear before the Royal Court for trial.

DAVY JONES VISITS WISCONSIN

The following is the text of the message delivered by Davy Jones for His Majesty Neptunus Rex:

In the two pages that follow, CHSCLK J.G. Brundies, USN, attempts to tell the true story of how he remained a Pollywog in Uncle Sam's Navy for over 20 years....

— THE ADDRESS OF "POLLYWOG" BRUNDIES—

Gentlemen of King Neptune's Domain - or as you probably will turn out to be prior to the setting of this sun the wreckers of the "Pollywog Brigade."

I have been brought before your honorable court to plea my case. A case you call it - with the jury packed with blood-thirsty torture bearers. "Shellbacks" I believe is the name. The group of people within this ship who have been strutting about of late with a definite air of superiority making written and verbal attacks on our character.

I stand before you convicted of being a "land-lubber" - of all things. I have served my country at sea and on foreign shores for twenty odd years and explicitly carried out all orders received whether it be in the Pacific, in the Atlantic or the Mediterranean. I have probably spent more time in a motor launch trying to get ashore after a long, hard voyage than most of you "Shellbacks" have spent on the water - be it fresh or salt. It is my firm belief that before the last war the greater majority of you "Shellbacks" were a group of triple "S" and "CR" sailors. San Diego, San Pedro and San Francisco explains the three "S's". And of course you have sailed the Chesapeake long enough to know that "CR" stands for "Chesapeake Raider."

While I was on sea duty operating out of Pearl Harbor, I was ordered back to Washington, thence to the war zone. You so called "Shellbacks" were so engrossed with shore duty in the U. S. and making an occasional excursion into the Bay, that the actual sea duty and dangerous assignments were left to us "land lubbers." I hardly feel that the term "land lubber" applies to a lot of us as it was 18 long years before I was assigned duty ashore in the U. S. Of course I am not counting the years I spent riding the Norfolk - Newport News Ferry, the years that I was in the Mississippi River Patrol nor the years sailing Lake Michigan.

A war was thrust upon us in December 1941 and all our ships had to put to sea. Yes, they cut the chains that secured

your ships to the docks and the lines that secured them to the buoys. During the course of the war we were compelled to send our ships "south of the border" and it was not until then that most of you "shellbacks" ever got beyond the three mile limit.

During the early part of 1941 when you, the jurors were about the shores of our beloved country, chasing the fair ladies of our land, I was in England amidst the air raids and buzz bombs. We tried to stave off a total war so that your mooring lines would not have to be cut. I must agree that as time passed, the tide of battle in Europe changed considerably and I found the duty was extremely to my liking. I worked under ideal conditions in a spacious, clean and comfortable office with valet service, if you please. At night I was free to roam the streets of London seeking love, adventure and excitement while you so-called "Shellbacks" were fighting the war in and around the hot, dissolute and fever ridden islands of the South Pacific.

I believe in the laws of the sea and the traditions that they have established. Having carried out all duties assigned I have no apologizes to make for not being a "seven-seas" sailor, or in your language, a "Shellback." However, I feel that we, the land-lubbers who were first to go forth in answer to the call of duty, should not be judged too severely because our sails were set east and west while yours, through necessity, were set north and south.

In conclusion Gentlemen, Gentlemen being used for lack of a better word, I would like to say that "I feel like a June Bride" except that I am not too happy over what I am about to receive.

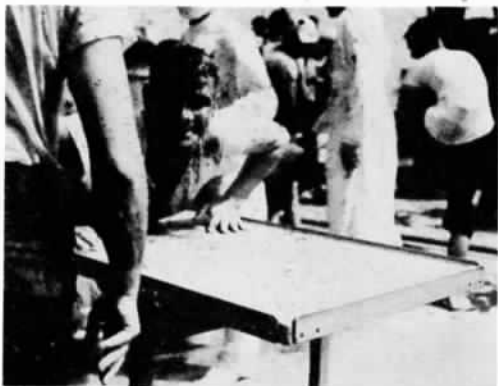
